●TRIAL IMPLEMENTATION OF A "PROGRAM FOR ALL CHILDREN TO ENROLL KINDERGARTEN/DAYCARE" ~Tama City is the first of the 26 cities in Tokyo~

We will implement on a trial basis a program that allows children who do not attend *hoikusho*/daycare center, etc., and will be taken care of at kindergarten or daycare centers. For guardians who want their children to have lots of fun with friends of the same age, have a teacher teach them songs and play with their hands, or just take a break, this is the place for them. This system is scheduled to be implemented nationwide from fiscal year 2026. Tama City will be the first to implement this system on a trial basis.

Target Infants/toddlers (6 mos.to below 3 years old living in Tama City) who are not attending or enrolled in a kindergarten or daycare center

Location Midorigaoka Kindergarten (Wada area), Fujigaoka Kindergarten (Kotta/Kaidori area), Aozora Nursery School (Tama Center area), Asunoki Nursery School (Nagayama area), *Eligibility varies depending on the location.

How to use Application begins April 1st (As a rule, you must submit your application online through the official website) After applying, there will be an interview with the daycare facility. The program is scheduled to start around May.
