Covid 19 Vaccine

Omicron vaccine (BA.4-5 vaccine) for 12 years and older

We will send vaccination tickets for the Omicron vaccine in mid-December to those aged 12 and over who received the second dose of conventional vaccine in October 2022.

■For those who are over 60 years of age: The city will send a vaccination ticket after specifying the vaccination date and time, group vaccination venue, and vaccine to be used in advance (the specified vaccination date and time are written on the vaccination ticket. It is changeable. For details, please refer to the notice enclosed with the vaccination ticket).

■For those who are between 12 to 59 years of age: You can start booking as soon as the vaccine ticket arrives to your home.

Be careful when handling gasoline and kerosene in winter

In winter, when the air is dry, the likelihood of a static electricity fire at a gas station increases. In addition, there are more opportunities to use gasoline or kerosene as fuel for heaters. Understand the dangers of gasoline and other hazards and reaffirm safe handling.

Those who use self-serve gasoline station should take care of the following •Turn off the engine •Be careful not to use the wrong fuel •Touch the static electricity removal sheet • Do not add additional oil • Refuel with correct operation • Be careful not to misplace the refueling cap • Do not put it in the container by yourself.
