

## FROM THE RECORD OF COUNTERMEASURES AGAINST TYPHOON HAGIBIS

Typhoon Hagibis or No. 19th typhoon in 2019, including a heavy rain special warning issued in 12 prefectures and Tokyo had caused major damage in a wide area of Japan. In Tama City, the risk of flooding and overflowing the Tamagawa River increased, and evacuation orders had been issued to 14,743 people in 8,221 households. In the evacuation centers set by the city alone 2,583 people had evacuated, making it an unprecedented disaster. Fortunately, there were no casualties, but flood damage and landslides had occurred in the city. Once again, let's prepare for future disasters such as reconfirming evacuation centers and how to evacuate, and stockpiling food and drinking water.

## EVERY NOVEMBER 12th - 25th IS THE PERIOD FOR THE NATION'S "ELIMINATION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN MOVEMENT"

\*For consultation, please contact a specialized organization such as the TAMA Women's Center! According to the "2017 Survey on Violence between Men and Women" conducted by the Cabinet Office, about half of the respondents who experienced domestic violence (DV) said that they had not consulted anywhere. Most of them did not because they thought it wasn't something to consult about. In the current situation, even those who were able to consult still didn't receive assistance from the official consultation organization and continue to suffer from DV.

Solving the problem between non-professionals is not possible and with the wrong advice may delayed escaping from domestic violence. Do not endure your sufferings alone.
