I cannot unlock the front door with my key. The toilet is clogged! BEWARE of the on-site repair services.

Troubles such as concerning door keys and matters around wet area are happening unexpectedly that likely to cause people to become frantic with haste or get upset; and may be charged of large amount depending on the locksmith sometimes. When asking for repair service, please make sure to contact several companies and request for the work details and charges; compare what they're offering. Also, it is important to reconfirm how much you'll be paying before the work begins, and have someone with you such as your family or a friend. So, in order to be always prepared in times like these, it would be very helpful if you gather information about the company that you can trust with.
