"I bought a vacuum cleaner by TV shopping channel, but it was heavy and hard to use. I phoned the selling company to return it, but they refused saying that they cannot accept the item since it has already been used." Although online shopping does not have the cooling-off system, the conditions are indicated concerning returning or exchanging of product. In shopping channel, it may be difficult to notice and understand some important matters such as the possibility of returning the product due to limited time, and also because the attention of the shoppers is mostly taken by the introduction of the products and with the feeling like a good bargain on it. When ordering through the shopping channel please make sure to confirm with the operator the conditions and procedures when returning and exchanging the product, how to use and its precautions before buying. In addition, even if there is an indication of non-returnable product, you can ask to return, repair or exchange it, if you found any defect or when a different product is delivered to you.
