THINK ON WHAT WE CAN DO FOR WASTE REDUCTION AND RECYCLING RESOURCES

October is "Reducing Food Waste Month". Let us start making the reduction right from our home with daily awareness on food loss.

- **1. Don't buy too much.** Check the household stock of ingredients in the fridge or pantry before shopping.
- **2. Consume completely.** Understand correctly the limit for consumption (*shohi kigen*) and the limit for best taste (*shomi kigen*) of foods. Consume them before the expiry date.
- 3. Eat everything. Be careful about preparing too much food and storing excessive quantities

October is "3R Promotion Month" (Tama City is promoting 4R that includes "Refuse")

*REDUCE=(Use things with care, reduce waste), Don't buy things you don't really need. Bring your own shopping bag. *REUSE= (Use products repeatedly) Choose a product that sells refills, give things away if you do not need them anymore. *RECYCLE= Separate waste and resources, use recycled products *REFUSE= Refuse unnecessary packaging, bring your own shopping bag and refuse plastic grocery bag
