NATIONAL PENSION VOLUNTARY ENROLLMENT SYSTEM FOR PEOPLE LIVING OVERSEAS OF JAPANESE NATIONALITY

Overseas residents will no longer be obligated to join the National Pension Plan, however, if they wish to join voluntarily, they may be able to increase the amount of pension in the future and receive a basic pension for the bereaved family or a disability pension if they die while living overseas or become disabled due to illness or injury.

*You cannot apply for an exemption, postponement of payment, or a special payment system for students while enrolled for voluntary coverage.

▽Eligible: Japanese nationals aged 20 to 65 years old living overseas and the last address in Japan is Tama City. *Welfare pension insured persons and their dependent spouses are excluded.

∇Payment method: (1) Use the payment form sent to insured person's proxy in Japan; (2) Withdrawal from savings account in Japan

∇Things to bring: Pension book or individual number (*my number*), *inkan* (seal), identity verification documents such as driver's license, passport, etc.

*If you wish to make a direct debit, you will need to bring your passbook together with your personal seal which you used when you open a bank account.
