You cannot apply to have your bulky garbage collected on Saturday, April 27~Monday, May 6. If you wish to have it collected on Monday/holiday, April 29 ~ Tuesday, May 7, please make your application by 3:00pm Friday, April 26 through the *Sodai Gomi Senyo Dial*.

Also, in order to bring the bulky garbage directly to the waste incineration plant on Sunday, April 28 \sim Friday/holiday, May 3 & 6, please file your application by 5:00pm, April 26.

*Be sure to dispose the bulky garbage until 8:00am on the scheduled day of collection.

PRENATAL AND POSTNAL PERIOD EXEMPTED FROM PAYING NATIONAL PENSION PREMIUM

A system to exempt from paying National Pension and Insurance premiums during prenatal and postnatal period begins from April 2019.

▽Eligible: Those category 1 insured persons of National Pension who gave birth on Feb. 2019 and later. **However, this doesn't apply to the members of Welfare Pension and their dependent spouses. You need to contact your employer as there is similar system like this one.

ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE TAMA FIRE DEPARTMENT

ARE YOU SAFE? CHECK THE CAUSES OF HOUSE FIRES

The deaths caused by house fires are increasing suddenly this year. Let us prevent it by re-inspecting our home by ourselves; do checks \square the following items.

[Cigarette] The leading cause of death every year.

- □ Never smoke in bed.
- ☐ Beware of drinking alcohol→ smoke→take a nap
- □ Do not pile cigarette butts in the ashtray.
- □ Soak cigarette butts in the water before disposing.
- □ Smoke in a safe place and avoid dropping any source of fire.

[Portable cooking stove] The primary cause of house fires. Be careful of clothing not to catch on fire!

- □ Never leave the kitchen when cooking.
- □ Do not put any flammable items around the stove.

[Electrical cords] Fire danger exists close to us!

- □ Unplug electrical appliances when not in use.
- □ Clean the plugs and outlets regularly.
- □ Avoid overloading power strips.
- □ Be careful not to bend the cords or be pinned under the appliances.
- □ Do not use bundled cords.
- ☐ Use fire-resistant apron and arm cover.
- □ Adjust the flame to confine to the bottom surface of the pot.
- □ Use the cooking stoves with fire safety systems.

Be prepared in case of fire! Have fire alarm in your home! A residential fire alarm system detects fire early and it will help to protect your life as well as your family. So, be sure to install it.
