BE RESPONSIBLE AND SHOW AFFECTION TO YOUR PET FOR ITS ENTIRE LIFE

September 20th (Fri.) to September 26th (Thu.) is a "Be Kind to Animals Week"

*Don't forget to register your dogs and have them vaccinated against rabies

In order to prevent the spread of rabies, the registration of pet dogs and annual rabies vaccinations are required by law. Be sure to put a nameplate and vaccination slip on your dog.

*Avoid causing nuisance with people around you

Be sure to connect with leads while taking for a walk. If they pee, it's your responsibility to wash it away with water and take the dung home.





*Keep cats indoors

Keeping a cat outside can lead to infection and traffic accidents. Also, they may cause trouble to your neighbors if they pee or dung at the house of someone else, or may cause a nuisance when they make loud yowling sounds when quarreling or in estrus. Don't forget to have them spayed or castrated.
