Check the hazard map

Evacuation methods vary depending on the situation in the area you live in. Please check on how you should evacuate by referring to "Tama City Flood and Landslide Disaster Hazard Map" distributed to all households in March 2020. By putting a corresponding check mark □ on the table below you will be able to act smoothly in times of emergency. If your house is not in the below six areas, in principle, you should take shelter at home. However, if you live near a cliff and you notice a precursory phenomenon or signs of landslide such as cracks in the cliff, small stones falling and water overflowing from the cliff, leave the place and evacuate immediately.
