WHAT SHOULD I DO IF A TYPHOON HITS VInquiries: Bosai Anzen-ka ☎042-338-6802

In order to prevent the spread of the new coronavirus disease (COVID-19) and protect the lives of each individual, the city is also taking measures based on the new evacuation concept presented by the Cabinet Office. While giving priority to your life, please consider whether you can take shelter at your home, evacuate to your relative's house, or evacuate by car.

Select from the three methods below on how you will evacuate

Evacuate by Vehicle

Use your car as a shelter. Park in a safe place designated for evacuation. Evacuate as early as possible.

Evacuate to the homes of relatives or friends Evacuate to the house of relatives or friends who live in a safe place. Also consider evacuating to a hotel.

Take shelter at home Check the water level and weather information frequently. If the risk increases, evacuate to the upper floor (vertical evacuation)

When you have nowhere to evacuate

Take refuge in the evacuation shelter

If it may take you time to do so, evacuate early. Use public transportation as much as possible when moving to the shelter. Put your pet in a carrier or cage when evacuating.

In times of flooding, you can check the opening and crowding status of each evacuation shelter in the City on the Internet. When evacuating, go to a shelter with fewer evacuees as much as possible.
