# SPECIFIC HEALTH CHECK-UP FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 WILL START IN MAY

With the health checkup, the risk of lifestyle diseases such as dyslipidemia and diabetes will be examined. Lifestyle-related diseases are illnesses that have no subjective symptoms at first, and when they are noticed, the disease progresses and often interferes with life.

By finding the risk of illness early and taking action can prevent it or slow down its progression.
