VACCINATION APPOINTMENTS NOW BEING ACCEPTED

Vaccinations for those who are twelve years old and older are available at forty-five medical institutions in Tama City and at Link Forest (3-5-3 Tsurumaki). If you wish to be vaccinated, please make an appointment. The vaccines are expected to be supplied as scheduled. VACCINATION CERTIFICATE OF COVID-19 (VACCINE PASSPORT)

The certificate of vaccination for COVID-19 is used when you are asked to show your vaccination certificate to ease quarantine measures when entering a foreign country.

- Target: Those who are registered residents of Tama City on the day of vaccination and plan to travel abroad. *If you do not plan to travel abroad, but need to have proof of vaccinations, please use the "Certificate of Vaccination/Vaccination Record" issued at the vaccination site.
- •Fee: Free of charge

FROM TAMA FIRE DEPT. ~USING AMBULANCE SERVICES PROPERLY~

The number of emergency cases under the jurisdiction of the Tokyo Fire Department reached a record high in the last fiscal year. More than half of these patients were diagnosed to have minor illnesses by primary care physicians (PCP). There is a risk that lives that could be saved may not be saved as fewer ambulances left when dispatched for minor illnesses causing delays in arrival at the emergency site for those with serious illnesses.

USE AMBULANCE AT TIMES LIKE THESE

- Unconscious (no response)
- Injuries with severe bleeding
- Extensive burns
- Something is wrong with the baby
- · Continuous seizure
- · Choking on something, having difficulty to breath, unconsciousness
 - Traffic accident, drowning, falls from a high place
 - · Hives in children, having pale face

If you have a sudden illness or injury and not sure whether or not to call an ambulance, please call the Tokyo Fire Department Emergency Consultation Center (#7119)

The emergency consultation medical team (staffed by doctors, nurses and experienced paramedics) is available all the time to provide information on medical institutions and emergency consultation.
