COVID-19 VACCINATION Accepting reservations for those 16 years & older

All bookings for those aged 65 years and older who wished to be vaccinated have been closed. The second round of vaccinations will be completed by the end of July.

Tama City sent out the vaccination coupons for people aged 16 to 64 on June 30. If you do not receive it by Sat., July 10, please contact the (Novel Coronavirus) COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center (**2**042-313-7003) (in Japanese only). We will start accepting reservations on Mon., July 5, so please make an appointment if you wish to be vaccinated. Vaccination coupons will also be sent to those aged 12 to 15 years old in July. RECHECK YOUR EVACUATION METHOD IN PREPARATION FOR HEAVY RAIN

Evacuation site (other than shelters)

There are three options for evacuation. Think about what kind of evacuation you can do and which one applies to you. First of all, please check if your house is in the danger zone by using the "Tama City Flood and Landslide Hazard Map" distributed to all households in March 20. If there is no applicable one, in principle, evacuate at home. %Hazard maps are also available on the official website.

 \bullet Home and vertical evacuation \rightarrow Upper floor of home or nearby building

 $\blacklozenge Horizontal evacuation \rightarrow \bullet Relatives evacuation: Evacuate to relatives, friends' homes, accomodation facilities$



•Vehicle evacuation (For a short time or when you can take care of your health) •Aqua Blue Tama multi-story parking space, *Nikoh Sangyo* NSP *Kenko Fukushi* Plaza parking space, Bellebs Nagayama parking space

Evacuate to a shelter

Use the evacuation center congestion check system to find out which one has fewer evacuees and then evacuate. (*You can access from the QR code on the right* \rightarrow)
