## ACCEPTING RESERVATION FOR MASS VACCINATION AGAINST COVID-19 RESUMED

Mass vaccination against the new coronavirus using Takeda/Moderna vaccine will be conducted at the Health Center starting October 16. If you would like to be vaccinated, please take this opportunity by making an appointment. \*Those who have already received two doses of the vaccine or those who have received the Pfizer vaccine are not eligible to receive this vaccine.

- •Vaccinations will be offered to residents 16 years of age and older, appointment is not necessary!

  (Has capacity limits) Please come to the Health Center during the vaccination hours with your identification documents.

- •Priority vaccination will be given to residents over 12 years old who are preparing for the entrance exam! (Has capacity limits) Appointments by phone are accepted at the COVID Vaccination Call Center for students who will be taking the exam.

# REDUCE THE AMOUNT OF "FOOD LOSS" FROM OUR HOME THROUGH DAILY PRACTICE!

October 16th (Saturday) is World Food Day, a day set by the United Nations to consider the world's food problems.

## Have some consideration by practicing it in our daily lives

(1) Be careful not to buy too much? →Check your refrigerator and the ingredients in your kitchen, and buy only what you need. (2) Get the items on display in the forefront. →Understand the difference between "best before" and "consume-by" dates, and buy from the items displayed in the front. (3) Use up, consume completely →Use all ingredients without wasting them, and prepare only the amount you can eat. If you happen to have some leftovers, freeze or try other ways to store or remake them. (4) Eat everything →Eat as much as possible without leaving any food behind. When eating out, order only the amount of food you can eat.

In October 2019, the "Food Loss and Waste Reduction Promotion Act" was enacted and October 30<sup>th</sup> was designated as "Food Loss Reduction Day.

### INFORMATION FROM TAMA FIRE DEPT. ~ LEARN HOW TO CALL 119! ~

If a fire breaks out, or a person is suddenly sick or injured in front of you, your prompt and correct 119 call will help protect that person's life and property. Learn the correct procedure so that you can call 119 calmly even when it is very urgent.

- •How the 119 call works If you call 119 from a landline, public phone, or smartphone in the city, you will be connected to the Tokyo Fire Department's Disaster and Emergency Information Center (Tachikawa City), and the fire fighters or paramedics near the site will be ordered to go into action. If you are in an area with poor reception, please call from a landline or public phone to avoid interrupting the conversation during the call.
- •Proper reporting procedures When calling 119, speak slowly and audibly, giving your address and the nature of the disaster.
- •If you are not sure whether you should call an ambulance or not Even in the case of injury or illness, if you are not sure whether you should call an ambulance or not, please use the Emergency Consultation Center #7119. # BE SURE TO TAKE A BREAST CANCER SCREENING FROM AGE 40

Are you thinking that you're fine? The peak age of the breast cancer incidence is in the 40s to 60s. Early detection is of utmost importance, as more than 95% of patient can be cured if the cancer can be detected while it is still small.

•Make your reservation now! Notifications for breast cancer screening are sent to women who are aged 40 years or older and who will reach an even age within this fiscal year.

**∇Period covered:** Until March 31, 2022 **∇Eligible:** Those who are 40 years old or older and will be of even-numbered age this year. **∇Fee:** 1,500 yen **∇Things to bring:** The medical checkup information envelope sent at the end of April (the envelope itself is your medical checkup ticket) and health insurance card.

<Notes> If you have lost your envelope, or if your age is odd-number who did not receive a medical exam in the previous year and would like to be examined this year, please inquire.
