But the number of infected people in their teens to 50s has increased rapidly.

Whether you are at home or out, it is important to take basic infection prevention measures such as wearing a mask, washing hands and disinfecting fingers. Also, please refrain from traveling to other prefectures and avoid contact with anyone other than your family as much as possible. With your actions, you can protect your loved ones.
