ABOUT COVID VACCINATION FOR CHILDREN (AGE 5 TO 11 YEARS OLD)

◆It is not mandatory. Please think about it carefully.◆

To parents/guardians Parent or guardian's consent (signing the pre-medical checkup form with the vaccination ticket) and their presence are required when vaccinating a child. Please refer to the following information beforehand enclosed with the vaccination ticket --the "Notice on COVID Vaccination" (prepared by the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare), "COVID vaccine Q&A" posted on the website of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare, "Pfizer's COVID vaccination instructions (for children aged 5 to 11 >)", "Thoughts on COVID vaccination of children aged 5 to 11 years "posted on the website of the Japan Pediatric Society, "For parents of children aged 5 years old and over who are considering inoculation with the COVID vaccine," posted on the website of Pfizer Inc.

If you have any concerns, please consult your family doctor or other health care provider before making a decision on vaccination.

Sending out of vaccination ticket to citizens aged 5~11 years old

- Those born between Mar. 7, 2010 and Mar. 6, 2017 = already sent out on Feb. 25 (please inquire if you have not received your vaccination ticket)
- •Those born on or after March 7, 2017 = To be sent consecutively at the end of the month of their 5th birthday

Priority reservations

Children with underlying medical conditions such as chronic respiratory disease and congenital heart disease that has a <u>high risk</u> of becoming severe, and wish to get a shot will receive priority reservations at the COVID Vaccination Call Center.


