NEW CORONAVIRUS (COVID) VACCINATION

• About initial vaccination, booster vaccination and children vaccination

Currently, the first and second doses as well as the third additional dose are administered to those aged 12 years and above, and the first and second doses for children aged 5 to 11 years. Please make an appointment if you wish to be vaccinated. For details, please refer to the official website.



About fourth booster vaccination

The city is preparing for the vaccination system in case the fourth dose of the new coronavirus vaccine is regarded as an immunization under the Immunization Law, based on a notice from the national government. Whether or not to administer the fourth shots and who would be eligible, and the interval between the third shot will be decided after deliberations by the National Health Sciences Council's Subcommittee on Immunization and Vaccines.

New information will be announced through Tama Koho newsletter and the official website of Tama City as it becomes available.

COLLECTING HAND STAMPS! PLEASE SHARE YOURS. HAND STAMP ART EXHIBITION

To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the implementation of the shisei (granting of a city status), painters Makoto Tagawa and Shinya Fukasawa will create an artwork using the "hands" of everyone who has made the past fifty years of Tama City and the coming peaceful fifty years. Your "hands" will be used to create a single large art work of nine meters wide, expressing "Everyone smiles and lively town, Tama" by connecting the hands of many people.

HOW TO MAKE HAND STAMP

Apply paint or stamp ink of your desired color to the palm of your hand, press it onto a plain colored drawing paper, let it dry, and then cut it out with scissors along the shape of your hand. Write your name and favorite words on the front of the cut-out hand stamp.

NOTE: On the back side, you need to write your age (10s, 50s, etc.). Those who have difficulty with handprints may use footprints. The completed work will be exhibited at the Parthenon Tama in July to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the city's establishment. Please refer to the official website for details.

A FIRE BROKE OUT FROM A GARBAGE TRUCK!

~ Spray can should be disposed of as "hazardous waste" ~

Before throwing out your garbage, STOP! Think carefully! ? Your actions can prevent fires. Follow the rules and manners of sorting, and dispose of garbage safely!

- *A fire broke out in a garbage truck in Tama City. The cause of the fire is under investigation, but many spray cans and other "hazardous waste" were found in the garbage collecting truck, which had been disposed in "non-burnable" garbage bags.
- *Spray cans, cassette gas canisters, lighters and so on, must be emptied of their contents and disposed of as "hazardous waste" (free of charge) without making holes in them. NEVER put them in the "Non-burnable Garbage" (pink plastic bags). Please refer to the official website for details.


