With more opportunities to go to the beach, rivers and swimming pools, summer is the season when water-related accidents are most likely to occur. Accidents involving children under 9 years old are the most common, so when playing in the water with young children, be sure to keep a close eye on them, check the weather information and take all necessary precautions to avoid accident. Remember that at the water's edge, the current can suddenly become faster or rapidly increase in depth. Be alert, and have fun playing in the ocean, rivers, and swimming pools. Ocity Hall is sending out important notices on Long-Term Care Insurance and National Health Insurance

Notices of nursing care insurance premiums for fiscal 2023 will be mailed out in mid-July to those aged 65 and above. In addition, those who are certified as requiring nursing care or support will be mailed a nursing care insurance premium rate certificate by mid-July at the latest.

To those who are enrolled in the National Health Insurance System, your current insurance card is valid until September 30; a new card, which can be used from October 1, will be mailed to you by registered mail during September. If you wish to receive it by a different method because you have submitted a forwarding notice to the post office or are frequently away from home, please contact the Insurance and Pension Section on 042-338-6824 by July 31 (requests received after August 1 will not be accepted).
