## Beware of heat stroke!

Heat stroke is caused by staying in a high temperature and humidity environment for a long time, which gradually disrupts the balance of water and salt in the body, and heat is generated in the body. It is a state of muffling.

- ◆To protect yourself from heat stroke
  - ★ Avoid the heat ★Replenish water and salt frequently ★Prepare your body for the heat
  - ★Manage your health on a daily basis


