For those who are enrolled in National health insurance or Latter-stage elderly healthcare system

• The current insurance card can be used until the expiration date •

From December 2, Reiwa 6, My Number Card and health insurance card will be integrated, and new issuance of the current health insurance card will end. However, the current health insurance card can be continuously used until its expiration date stated on it (September 30, Reiwa 7 for the National Health Insurance, July 31, Reiwa 7 for the Latterstage elderly healthcare system). We will inform you of the details after December 2, Reiwa 6, as soon as they come decided. Inquiries: Insurance and Pension Division (The reception might be very crowded from July to August.)

For those who have difficulty in paying National Pension Insurance Premium

The primary insured person having financial difficulties in paying the insurance premium can apply for exemption or deferral of payment of the insurance premium. The person, already having received an exemption and wish to continue it after July, needs to complete the exemption procedures again, except for those who are entitled to the continuation.
