●The child allowance system will be expanded from October 2024

△Changes(1) Income restrictions will be lifted

- (2) The payment period will be extended to high school age
- (3) Payment amount for the third child and onwards will be 30,000 yen per month
- (4) Children of college age or younger who are up to the end of the fiscal year when they turn 22 will be counted as eligible children as a multiple child allowance
- (5) Payments will be made six times a year, every other month (even months), instead of three times a year.

 \triangle If any of the following apply to you, you must complete the procedure.

[New application] •If your eligibility expired due to excess income in Tama City by September 2024 and you are not receiving child allowance (special benefit) •If you are raising only high school-aged children •If you have never applied for child allowance in Tama City before

[Application for increase] •If you are already receiving benefits for a junior high school student or younger, but a high school student has not been recognized as a child eligible for the calculation. •If you are raising three or more children, including a child between the end of the fiscal year when he or she turns 18 and the end of the fiscal year when he or she turns 22.
