# PLAN AHEAD WHEN APPLYING FOR DISPOSAL OF OVERSIZED GARBAGE **DURING THE YEAR-END AND NEW YEAR HOLIDAYS!**

Oversized Garbage Collection ··· You must apply in advance to have your items collected or if you want to take them to the garbage disposal facility. Please refer to the "Garbage and Recyclables Collection Calendar" to check the collection days.

- △For direct disposal at a garbage disposal facility: If you have applied by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 27, you may take the items to the facility until 4:30 p.m. on Monday, December 30. XYou must call in advance to make an appointment to bring items in. XThere's a limit in the number of items. Applications for the New Year will be accepted from 8:30 a.m. Mon., Jan. 6.
- $\Delta$ Garbage and recyclable items must be put out by 8:00 a.m. !

As the amount of garbage and recyclable items is expected to increase during year-end and New Year holidays, the time for collection will change significantly than regular days. Garbage and recyclables disposed of after 8:00 a.m. will not be collected.

### $\Delta$ Temporary collection of burnable garbage will be on Saturday, January 4, 2025

Target areas: Kaidori 1~5-chome, Nagayama, Suwa, Minamino, Ochiai, Tsurumaki, Sannoshita, Nakazawa, Karakida, Toyogaoka

\*Collection may start at 8:00 a.m. even in areas where garbage collection truck usually comes in the afternoon due to changes in the collection route.
