The new issue of Health insurance card will be terminated

From December 2nd, the system will change being based on the My Number Card as a Health insurance card (*). You can continue to use your current health insurance card until September 30, Reiwa 7, if you are enrolled in the National Health Insurance, and until July 31, Reiwa 7, if you are enrolled in the Medical Care System for the Elderly. At the time of (new) enrollment or renewal, we will issue a "Notice of Credentials" for those who have a My Number Card as a Health insurance card, and a "Certificate of Eligibility" for those who do not have it. To those who are enrolled in the Medical Care System for the Elderly, a "Certificate of Eligibility" will be issued until July 31, Reiwa 7, regardless of the holding status of their My Number Card as a Health insurance card. (*) My Number Card as a Health insurance card is a such My Number Card which is usable as a health insurance card. 


