HELPING CHILDREN ADJUST TO SCHOOL LIFE IN JAPAN

Japanese language support and teaching are aimed at children who speak a language other than Japanese in everyday life and currently attending public elementary and junior high schools in Tama City, so as to easily adapt and adjust to the school life in Japan and to be able to understand the lessons quickly.

STEP 1 [Program entrusted by Tama City]

The entrusted organizations by the Tama City Board of Education will provide Japanese language support and teaching to children.

Program entrusted to: Tama City International Center (TIC) and/or

Action for a Better International Community (ABIC)

Who are eligible: Those children who are currently attending public elementary and junior high schools

in Tama City, and who are using their mother language in daily life.

Place : At the school where the child is attending

Number of sessions: Up to 35 times

Length of time: From 90 to 120 minutes per session

Language instruction: The mother language of a child or in Japanese

Fee : No charge

How to apply: Please apply to child's homeroom teacher. Then, the documents will be given to you.
